The audience was reconfigured in the process, transformed into the target, object, and conquest of the Futurist performance artist. According to Christina Poggi, Futurist discourse represents the audience in the figure of la folla, or the crowd—a phantasm of fear and fascination (711). The Futurists wanted to exploit the unruly energy of the crowd, yet remain superior, autonomous, and in control.

Alongside inaugurating the manifesto as a poetic form, Futurism created a combative style of declaiming poetry that would help define 20th-century performance art, reworked by Dada at the Cabaret Voltaire, Antonin Artaud in his Theatre of Cruelty, and the punk scene in the 1970s.
